MAYLENE RASMUSSEN

Maylene is a graduate of the Florence Academy of Art in Italy where she honed her drawing and painting skills in the tradition of classical realism. She learned lacquer painting at the Hanoi University of Fine Arts in Vietnam.

Born in the ancient Gandharan Buddhist city of Taxila in northern Pakistan, a country where she spent most of the next half century, Maylene is a world citizen who has lived and exhibited in Pakistan, Vietnam, Jordan, Bangladesh, Italy, USA, Kenya and now Nigeria.

Maylene is passionate about celebrating life and beauty through figurative and natural imagery, inspired by people and places wherever she is to create art that is unbound by tradition, culture or creed.

As part of an ongoing global series portraying the *Women* of my World, Maylene has spent the past year in Abuja


creating these 19 lacquer paintings. Drawing from life, her portraits celebrate the beauty, energy, resilience and creativity of African women she has met.

LACQUER PAINTING

MAYLENE'S PROCESS

A complex layering of mixed media on specially prepared boards results in images that emerge from a magical play of light, colour and texture. The effect subtlety and continually changes and captivates depending on lighting and the viewer's perspective.

- 1. Starting with a specially prepared lacquer board from Vietnam, Maylene carves shallow indented spaces based on her drawing. Eggshell (or other shell) is inlayed, held in place by applying lacquer under and over.
- 2. The shell is sanded to create a smooth and patterned finish.
- 3. Lacquer mixed with different pigments is layered onto the board using a variety of techniques to create a kaleidoscope of colour and texture.
- 4. Silver and gold leaf, and silver powder, may also be applied at various stages.
- 5. Sanding and polishing throughout the process, brings to light colours and patterns from the underlying layers. A final application of clear lacquer is the finishing touch.



LACQUER PAINTING

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

Lighting:

- Do not hang in direct sunlight.
- Artificial light and indirect sunlight are both great.
- Good lighting will enhance your enjoyment of the painting.


Cleaning:

- Clean with water and soft cloth.
- Do not use any chemicals.
- Be sure the cloth is clean to avoid scratching.












SUBLIME, Lacquer, silver and gold on board, 20cm x 15cm, 2019








