FOREWORD

We are very excited to hold Igbinovia Omon Sophia's first solo exhibition at Dolapo Obat Gallery in collaboration with Agama Art Publishing & Agency in Abuja, Nigeria.

Sophia has been working very hard to present her work, which features 25 pieces of metal foil and mixed media.

The *Her Wish* exhibition opens on 9th October and finishes on 23rd October 2020.

The exhibition consists of three large and 16 medium metal foils and five mixed media pieces.

Sophia's use of colour into the gaps of the metal foils, which translates her work into a common ground between painting, printmaking and bas-relief sculpture forms is particularly noticeable in these pieces. If adequately inked, her pictures could be printed as monotypes on specially prepared paper.

It is also fascinating to observe the way that she examines, in her work, how women crave to spend quality time with their children and family despite their busy schedules, an example can be found in her series called *The Joy Within*. This series tells the story of women that have achieved so much in their professional careers, but also seek subsistent existence in domestic chores.

In her *Balloon* series, the artist gives full rein to her painting abilities with children playing, walking and even sleeping with bright and colourful balloons.

Finally, the *Fearless* series shows different women looking boldly and confidently into the future.

Sophia's exhibition begins a collaboration between Dolapo Obat Gallery and I, in order to bring you a series of solo and collective exhibitions in different mediums such as painting, photography and sculpture throughout the year.

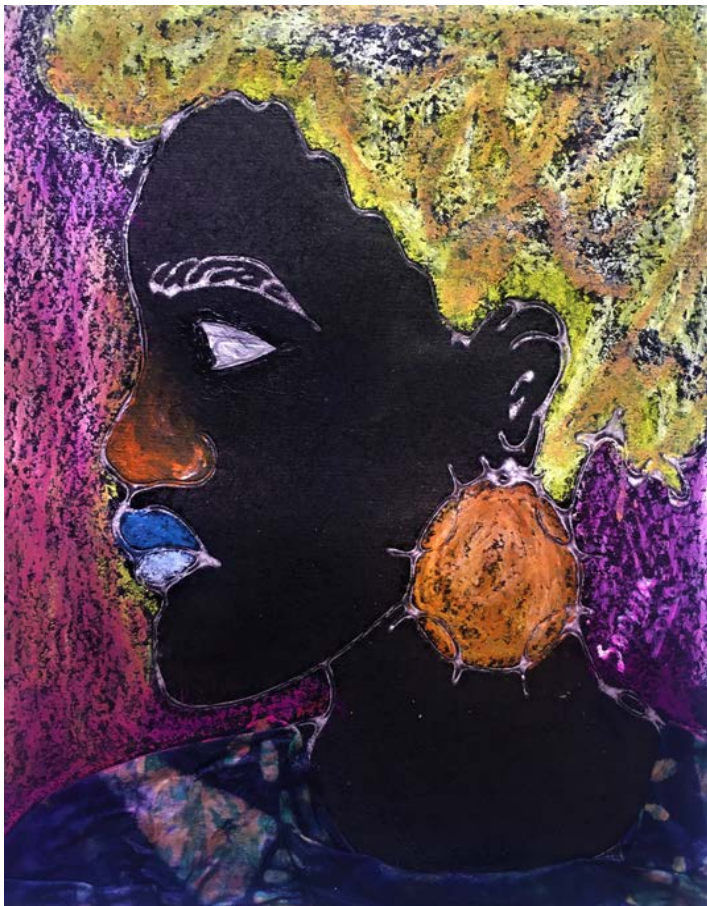

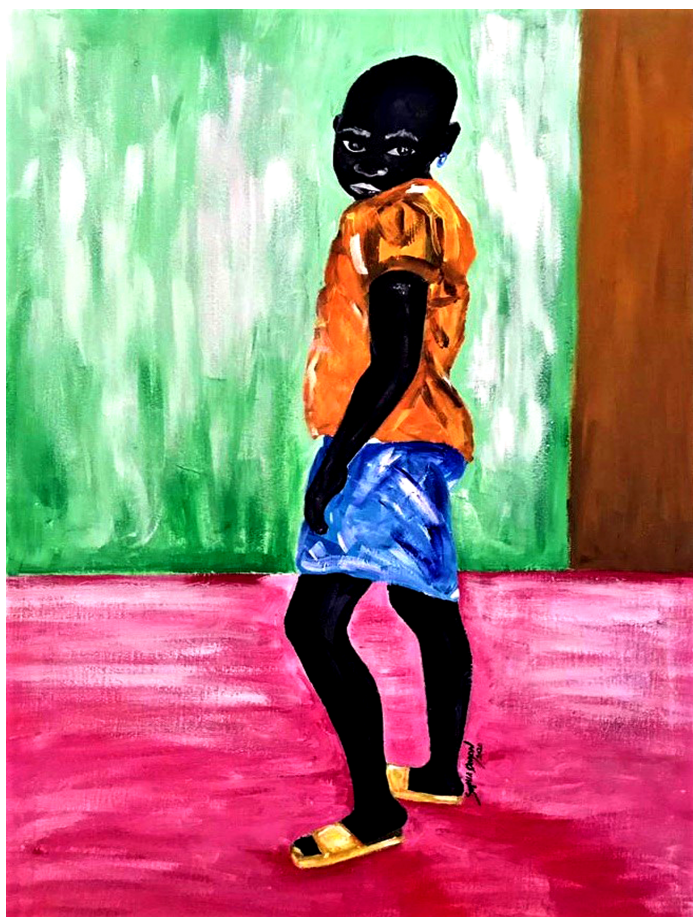

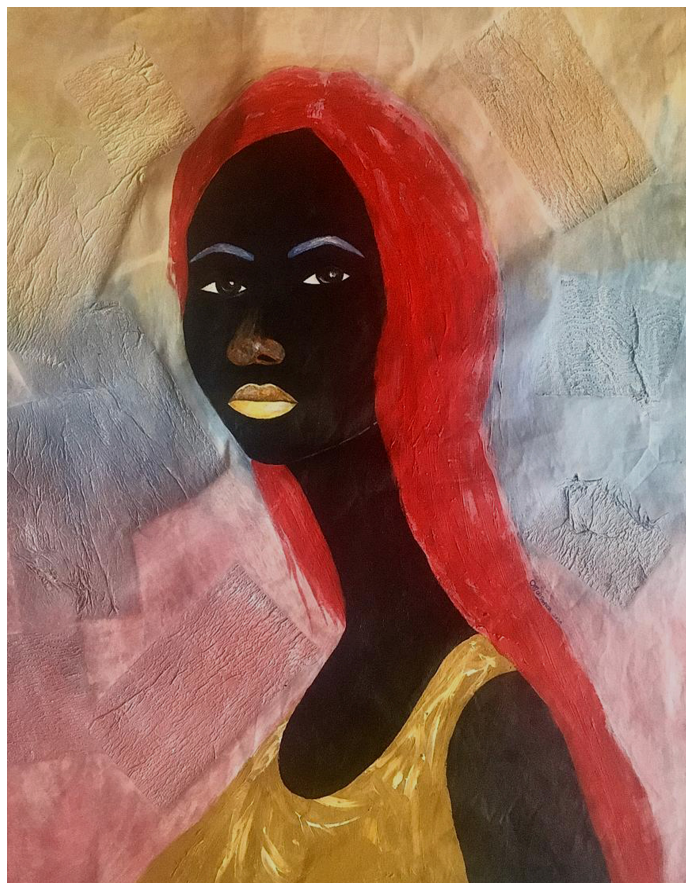
